- Satisfied families

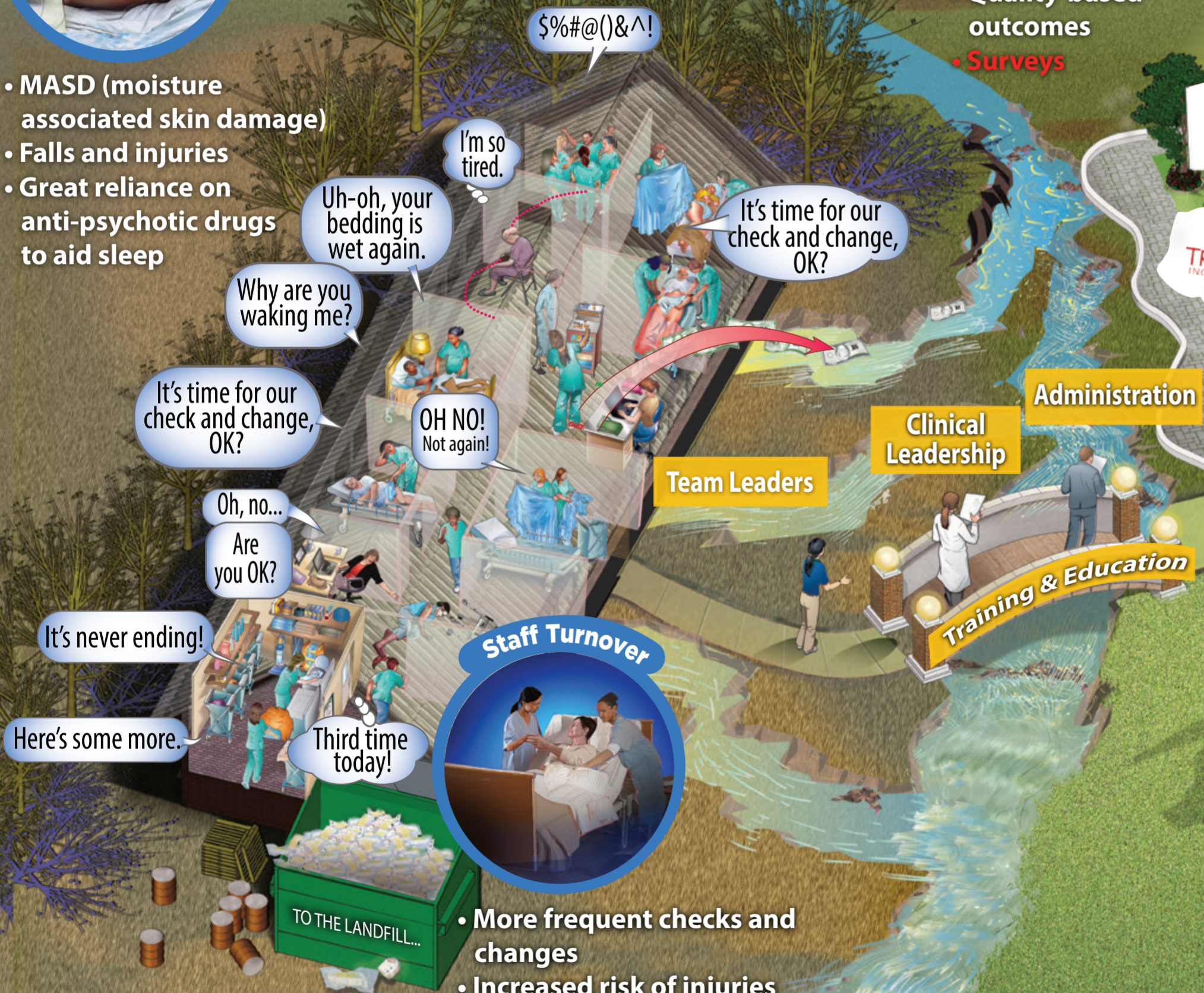
Clinical Outcomes/Quality of Care

- Improved **sleep** and activity
